Over the last 50 years Sancta Maria College has developed an outstanding reputation as one of the top creative schools in the country with many of its pupils progressing to study art and design in third level colleges. The majority of these students have continued to forge outstanding careers within creative fields both nationally and internationally. It is for this reason that as part of the Sancta Maria College Jubilee Celebration it is fitting that we highlight the exemplary achievements of the art teachers and the students themselves over the many generations.

Past pupils include internationally celebrated artist Isabel Nolan who represented Ireland in the 2005 Venice Biennale and Niamh Mc Cann, who presented a solo exhibition in The Hugh Lane Dublin City Gallery and who is currently nominated for the 2010 A.I.B. Prize. Both are represented in the collection of the Irish Museum of Modern Art. The exhibition will also feature works from curators, industrial designers, textile and multi-media artists among others. The exhibition spans generations of Sancta Maria College graduates from the late 70s to more recent graduates who are only beginning their creative pathways.

More than anything else this exhibition is a celebration of the creativity and ambition that was nurtured within Sancta Maria College over the last 50 years and will serve as an inspiration to the students who pass through the college doors for the next 50.
